## Reason behind forming the Trust:

“Aakash Maingwal Foundation” was set up on 03/09/2009. It started functioning from the same day. It has been formed to keep alive the memories of Late Aakash Maingwal only son and only child of Mrs Anupama Saxena. Aakash met with a fatal road accident in Lucknow on 08/01/2009 with none of his fault. His Alto Car was hit by a CNG Bus Carrying TELCO Employee's. The Employees did not bother to take him to the hospital. It was too late when the Police Ambulance Brought him to “Trauma Centre of King George Medical College” Lucknow.

He was 25 years and 4 months old at that moment of time and was working in AIRCEL, LUCKNOW as Senior Executive. He was an Electrical Engineer from B.I.T.

Since the age of 5 years, throughout he was always a helping hand to poor children's when in School and in College. He passed his Engineering Degree in the year 2005. He then worked in:

- WIPRO, Pune.
- News Communication, Noida.
- Percept Holdings, New Delhi.
- And finally “AIRCEL”, Lucknow.

All over his Job career of three and half years he helped the needy ones and underprivileged children's.

The Foundation has been formed to keep his memories alive.

- 3) Organize talent search examinations / competitions for poor children's and find out their field of interests and then grow them as per their talent so that they make themselves sufficient as far as their livelihood is concerned.
- 4) Find out and provide financial help / employment to poor children's who are not able to do higher studies for want of money / scholarships.
- 5) Provide primary education at least to all children's of disadvantaged communities.
- 6) Employment / Placement of different category children are as per their talent and capabilities.

- Educate children(s) of disadvantaged communities living and difficult to reach and inaccessible areas.
  - Provide Study Material (Books etc)
  - Provide Stationery (copy, pencil, eraser, drawing sheets, color pencils etc).
  - Provide clothes, blankets, school bags. umbrellas, food etc .
  - Provide a bit of entertainment such as magic shows.
- Arrange of the employment awareness camp / programs for the benefit of poor & needy students.

**AMF Ensure Proper Utilization of Funds:**

Ours is purely a non profit organization. All records of the underprivileged children's are being maintained separately. Expenditures done on every child is maintained. All the records can be verified any time with the children's / their legal heirs in person. The foundation is presently concentrating on the children's aged between 5 (five) years to 19 years mainly. Educating the street children's is the main motto of our trust. We are dedicated to provide English Medium Studies to needy children's.

**The trust believes in the following motives to educate underprivileged children's:**

- 1) Appointment of good tutors for teaching street children's.
- 2) Bring these children's to a certain level of literacy.
- 3) Convince / Ensure these children's that studies should be the main aim in life to earn livelihood.
- 4) Admission of these children's in English Medium Schools.
- 5) Ensure that they do well in studies by regular checking of their report cards and discussions with their class teachers.
- 6) Hold regular examinations separately to ensure their progress.
- 7) Regular counseling of these children's.
- 8) Arrange for Yoga classes, Personality Development classes, Games etc on regular basis.

### **Involvement of Management committee in the operation of our Foundation:**

- 1) **Mrs Anupama Saxena** - Fully involved in the foundation.

Being the mother of Late Aakash Maindwal, she has her main objective of grooming maximum number of underprivileged children's. She is putting full efforts in selecting the underprivileged children's from the streets, temples (beggars etc) and then teaching them. She is counseling and motivating them to become self dependent. She is daily Teaching Street children's for 5 to 6 hrs. Counseling of these children's is also done daily for one to two hours. Moral values have been preached to them and as well as the importance of education in life.

- 2) **Mrs Savita Saxena** – General Secretary – Same as Mrs Anupama Saxena. She is also fully involved.
- 3) **Shri Atul Saxena** – Teaching students for about two hrs daily and 4 hrs on Saturdays and Sundays. Counseling these children's for 3 to 4 hours on Saturdays and Sundays.
- 4) **Shri Akshat Saxena** - Same as Shri Atul Saxena.
- 5) Miss Tejal Soni - Same as Shri Atul Saxena.

### **Source of funding of our Foundation / Ttrust:**

**At present only relatives and friends are donating. We are putting our own money in small amounts. The generation of funds is very small. We have applied for rebate under 80 G and have received certification for the same by Director of Income Tax (Exemption) on 11.10.2010.**

### **Success of AMF:**

**AMF is quite successful** as the foundation since its formation (03/09/2009) has been educating the underprivileged children in house or in open area under roof. The following three underprivileged children's have been groomed for admission in public school.

- 1) **Miss Khushboo Kanojia, has scored 65 % Marks in her annual examination.**
- 2) **Miss Preeti Kanojia, has scored 40 % of Marks in her annual examination. She was a very weak student.**
- 3) **Miss Sandhaya Kanojia, has scored 93.4 % Marks in her annual examination.**
